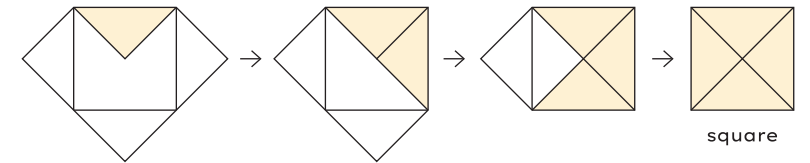
Our founding generation built Singapore with values like supporting racial harmony and not giving up when times were hard. Share your hopes and role in Singapore's future.



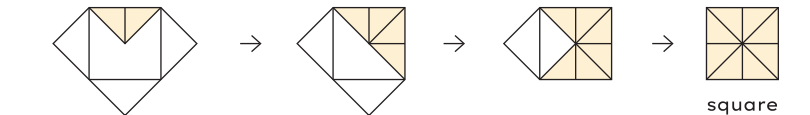
Folding Instructions

Tear along the dotted line to get your square piece of paper.

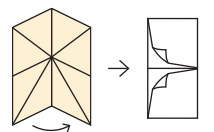
- 1 Start with the human images facing up. Fold all 4 corners to the centre.



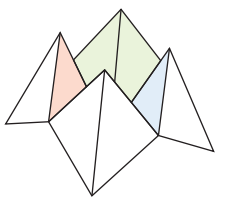
- 2 Turn your paper over and fold all 4 corners to the centre.



- 3 Fold the square paper into half, both horizontally and vertically.



- 4 Insert both of your forefingers and thumbs into the square pockets to open and close the chatterbox.



Now you are ready to play!

How to Play

- a Find a partner!
(Your parents/grandparents etc).
- b Ask them to pick a colour.
- c Spell out the colour while opening and closing the chatterbox. (E.g. If they pick red, you say "R-E-D" and open and close the chatterbox 3 times.).
- d Ask them to choose the icon that is shown inside.
- e Open the flap and ask them to share their answers to the question!
- f Repeat steps a to e until all the questions are answered.
- g Share your stories using the QR code below!
